**Bylaws Amendment and Revision
For Consideration at the 2019 Annual Conference Business Meeting
March 28, 2019**

Proposition 1: Treasurer to be an appointed position by the Board of Directors.

Article IV. Officers, Section 3 – Nomination, Election and Term of Office, of the current Bylaws of the Oklahoma Code Enforcement Association, or codification thereof to any future revisions of the Bylaws as voted upon by the membership, are hereby amended as follows by a favorable vote of a two-thirds majority of a quorum thereof:

In Paragraph A of Section 3: Nomination – The Treasurer's office shall be removed from nomination and consideration for election. Correspondingly in Paragraph F: Treasurer – A new Paragraph 1 shall be created (and subsequent paragraphs renumbered) to state that the Treasurer shall: ***“Serve as an appointed voting position of the Board of Directors for an indefinite term at the discretion of, and upon a favorable majority vote of, the other officer positions of the Board of Directors.”***
